

**REGULAR MEEETING MINUTES**  
**Town of Wittenberg**  
**April 20, 2010**

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Dick Beversdorf at 6:40 p.m.

Present were Chairman Beversdorf, Supervisors Neil Norrbom and Sandy Lewis, Treasurer Sue Hamm, Clerk Jacki Schmidt, and Road Supervisor Roger Krause. Also present were Don Beilke, David A. Schmidt, Joel Mueller, Ken Krolow, Rhonda Norrbom, Dana Kriha, Stuart Hanson, and Jesse Hanke.

The Plan Committee moved to the back room with Stuart Hanson to discuss his zoning matter.

The minutes of the March 16, 2010 meeting were read. A motion was made by Lewis and seconded by Norrbom to accept the minutes as read. Motion carried.

The Treasurer's report was read and will stand as presented. Balances in the accounts are as follows: NOW Account \$25,141.31, MMDA Account \$384,747.16, 0 balance in the Tax Account, and Gardner Park Account \$119,781.52.

Norrbom moved to deviate from the agenda and Lewis seconded. Motion carried.

Rhonda Norrbom from the Development Corporation spoke on creating a Fire District with the Village and gave figures on the cost. Discussion followed.

Motion was made by Lewis and seconded by Norrbom to give the Wittenberg Chamber Of Commerce a Temporary Class "B" License for June 19 at Fireworks Country. They have been informed that they need to be the ones selling the beer and must have someone on site at all times that has an Operator's License from the Town. Motion carried.

Sandy Lewis gave an update on the Electronics Recycling Day. The Village wants to join us in this endeavor. Discussion followed on how this will operate. Instead of getting labels from the County, Jacki will type up labels for the postcards. The date is June 19 from 10 a.m.-2 p.m.

The prices were given for the 70 chairs and storage rack for the back room. The Board decided to go with School Specialty for these as they gave us the lowest prices. Norrbom moved and Lewis seconded a motion to purchase 70 chairs and the rack for a total of \$1,281.90. Motion carried. Jacki will talk to the salesman for our area.

Open Book was set for Thursday, June 3 from 4-6- p.m. and Board of Review will follow from 6-8 p.m. People will need to make an appointment for Board of Review.

Lewis made a motion for a Resolution to turn over Tamarack Lane and Walnut Lane to the Shawano County Highway Department for the new road. The effective date is open until Chairman Beversdorf checks with the Highway Department on when they will be ready to maintain these two roads. Motion carried.

Norrbom moved and Lewis seconded a motion to donate \$700 to Wittenberg Community Days out of the Room Tax fund. Motion carried.

Norrbom moved and Lewis seconded a motion to donate \$5,000 to the Darwin E. Smith Aquatic Center out of the ATC funds. Motion carried.

A discussion followed on paying poll workers. A decision was made to pay poll workers by the hour for all their time and only for hours in attendance at training even though they are sometimes given credit for more hours toward certification than they actually attend.

The Plan Committee joined the meeting and recommended a rezoning of the Hanson property in the Town from General Agricultural/Open Natural to Intensive Manufacturing.

Motion was made by Lewis and seconded by Norrbom to change the zoning of the Hanson property as recommended by the Plan Committee as long as all state and county permits are obtained. Motion carried. The Town will publish any necessary notices for this to happen.

Chairman Beversdorf said that he talked to Jack Diffor about the area we would like to use for parking for the Wiowash Trail. An easement should be signed with the Town and Diffors. The Clerk will pursue this.

Norrbom made a motion to enact an ordinance addressing outstand Occupancy Taxes. A second was made by Lewis. The motion states that any entity not up to date on their Occupancy Tax as of June 30 will have their liquor license withheld for the upcoming year. (Ordinance #04-20-2010-1)

Communications were read from the Clerk.

Discussion followed on road projects for 2010. Oak Road will be covered by a TRIP. We will price it now and act on it after July 1 for the work to be done in early 2011. Other projects will be on Elm Road, Killdeer, North end of Robin, Birch, Meadowlark, Spruce, and Robin from Q to Hwy 29.

Weight limits were discussed because of a few incidents that happened this year. The question was how tolerant we should be. Next year we need to be more specific when someone calls about a variance.

Motion to adjourn was made at 9:05 p.m. by Norrbom and seconded by Lewis. Motion carried.
