

**TOWN OF WITTENBERG**  
**Regular Meeting Minutes**  
**May 18, 2010**

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Dick Beversdorf at 6:30 p.m.

Present were Chairman Beversdorf, Supervisors Neil Norrbom and Sandy Lewis, Treasurer Sue Hamm, Clerk Jacki Schmidt, and Road Supervisor Roger Krause. Also present were Roger Young, Don Yaggie from Fahrner, Bill Plucker from Scott Construction, Brenda Balthazor, and Jesse Hanke.

The minutes of the April 20, 2010 meeting were read. Added to those minutes was the fact that the motion on Tamarack and Walnut was seconded by Norrbom. A motion was made by Lewis and seconded by Norrbom to accept the minutes as corrected. Motion carried. The minutes of the Special Meeting on Wednesday, April 28, 2010 were read. An addition was also made to these minutes. Norrbom had seconded the motion to hold the public hearing. Norrbom moved and Lewis seconded to accept the corrected minutes. Motion carried.

The Treasurer's report was read and will stand as presented. Balances in the accounts are as follows: NOW Account \$43,025.19, MMDA Account \$385,044.42, 0 balance in the Tax Account, and Gardner Park Account \$119,874.06.

Norrbom moved to deviate from the agenda and Lewis seconded. Motion carried.

The road bids for blacktopping Meadowlark and Birch were opened. Motion was made by Norrbom and seconded by Lewis to award the contract to American Asphalt. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Norrbom and seconded by Lewis to wedge Robin Road North and then chip seal over the top. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Norrbom and seconded by Lewis to contract with Fahrner to do the crack filling with a cap of \$8,000. Motion carried.

The Plan Committee joined the meeting and said that the sign for Hickory should be Lane not Road. The zone change for the Hanson property is going through. Remind everyone that the hearing is on June 14 at 7 p.m.

We are going with Dynamic Recycling out of La Crosse for our electronic recycling this year. They are associated with our new garbage company, Harter's, and will be coming with boxes and pallets next week. We will have a 26 foot trailer on site that day. Cost is \$500 for the truck and \$50 for their man that will help that day.

Dick appointed the Plan Commission for 2010-2011. Members will be the same: Jesse Hanke, David A. Schmidt, Jim Haun, Joel Mueller, and Brenda Balthazor.

A discussion followed on the mowing. The price has increased by \$10 a time with less area to mow because of the playground. Also, there was a \$90 charge for brush & tree trimming, leaf removal, thatching, and removing debris that was not authorized by anyone on the Board. .Dick will talk to Jim about this before a decision is made on future mowing.

There was a request from a few citizens that have been taking care of the Robin Road Cemetery for some mowing to be done and possibly some money for paint. Dick thinks this is private property, but will check with Marion Boreen.

Discussion followed on the Rent-a-Flash bills. There have been a number of orders lately and each one has freight on it which is costing a lot. In the future we will try to limit ordering to once a month and possibly have someone pick up orders if they are going over that way.

A bill was received from the Village of Tigerton for a fire call. The Clerk was directed to get more information to help decide what should be done with the bill.

An example of an ordinance addressing the problem of outstanding occupancy taxes was given to the Board. The ordinance was looked at and the Board talked about what they would like to see in the ordinance. The Clerk was going to call the Towns Association to see how much of the ordinance example had to be included to be legal.

Chip sealing of Town roads was discussed. Dick will meet with someone from Fahrner to look over the roads proposed: Robin-Q to 29-1/4 mi., Elm-1/2 mi, Killdeer-1/4 mi, Robin North-379 feet, North Meadowlark-1/4 mi, Spruce 1/4 mi., McDivitt-1 mile, Apple-1/2/mi., and Robin from Birch to Maple-1/2 mi. Also discussed were Apple, Balsam, and Mavis west to the county line.

Motion by Lewis and second by Norrbom to adjourn at 9:28 p.m. Motion carried.
