

**Regular Meeting Minutes  
Town of Wittenberg  
February 16, 2010**

The Planning & Zoning Committee told the Board that they are looking at Covenants for Commercial Development.

Communications from the Clerk included a letter on spending the HAVA monies from 2009, one on construction projects and protecting the survey markers, information from Mid-State Truck, information from Bouncing Balls, and a reminder about the meeting in Pella coming up.
